Rules and Regulations

Bear on the Square Mountain Festival 2026

1. Sidewalks must remain clear. All equipment must be contained under tent area in allotted space.
2. No cleaning of equipment on site.
3. All trash/garbage must be removed to trash/garbage disposal bins.
4. No dumping of any liquid into city drains.
5. Signs and banners may not be more than 12' above the ground.
6. No generators without prior approval.
7. Safe Serve/Health Department Certificate must accompany application.
8. Food vendors preparing food on site must have a fire extinguisher on hand per city policy.
9. If you have special request or needs or extenuating circumstances they must be included with this application. It is impossible to make changes the day of check in, so it is imperative that any special needs you have are included with this application.
10. If you have cookers containing oil on the street you must have something under the cooker to absorb the grease that splatters out.
11. No refunds will be given after March 15, if you back out of being a vendor at the festival.
12. Spaces will be assigned by the Food Vender Committee with consideration of all vendor equipment and utility requirements, special needs disclosures, city ordinances as well as overall festival benefit and my not be changed at time of check in.
